Hours: Training week hours vary  
Monday-Wednesday, Middle/High School Enrichment Program, 11:00am-7:00pm  
Thursday, flexible hours for planning  
Friday, hours vary for trips and incentives

Job Description: Interns will plan, coordinate and/or implement the following:

- Academic enrichment
- Leadership and team development
- Elective courses
- Service project opportunities

Interns will work with middle and/or high school students leading lessons and activities. Additional duties include assisting with transportation, snacks, daily devotionals, upkeep of facilities, field trips, etc.

Funding:
