Function: To implement all program and instructional areas for middle or high school youth enrolled in after-school and summer programs, focusing on spiritual development, leadership, and preparation for next steps or life transitions.

Directly responsible to: Program Director and/or Coordinator

Immediate subordinates: Mentors, interns, and volunteers

Requirements: Personal confession of faith in Jesus Christ required. Must be a self-starter who enjoys and works well with others from a diverse background. Good communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills are also required.

Work experience: Must have some experience leading youth in spiritual as well as educational capacities.

Responsibilities may include:

- Coordinate with Program Director to carry out daily operation of middle/high school program
- Supervise and invest relationally in middle or high school students during academics, recreation, and transportation
- Lead students in Bible instruction
- Actively cultivate and develop relationships with parents, teachers, and community partners
- Assist with other administrative tasks
- Participate in fund development and special events for the organization

Additional considerations:

- Ability to work well with existing staff
- Part-time position, approximately 15-20 hours/week
- Hours vary but typically include late afternoon/early evening, 4-8pm
