

When facing a conflict with another student, Kimberly handles it with sensitivity, kindness, and honesty. She often has a word of encouragement





The Prescod Family


One significant part of the Youth Life program is long-term partnership with families. Ms. Alexa Prescod is the mother of six Youth Life students through the years: Junior, Cynthia, Alex, Leon, LenNexus, and Lionell. The Prescods started attending the Highland Park Learning Center back in 2008, and they have experienced the full scope of what Youth Life has to offer. They later moved and transferred to the Delmont Learning Center, eventually moving up into the Remix program.

In 2016, the Prescods went through significant family changes including a temporary move to New York, and these students who had grown up in the program were no longer with us.

This past year, Ms. Leahna Sullivan, our faithful Highland Park elementary teacher of over 10 years, was driving to pick up her students when Leon saw and recognized her. Leon, who was now older, much taller, and with dreads hanging from his head, approached her saying that he wanted to come back to the Learning Center.

Upon further conversation, not only did Leon want to come back, but his little brother, Lionell, also wanted to be in the program again. During a meeting with them and their mother, they shared that they had been spending their days in their room doing nothing and realized that they want to actually do something with their lives. Leon is now in the program with one year left of high school and is pursuing a career in graphic design. Lionell, with three years left of high school, is learning computer programming from a mentor and is going to apply for CodeRVA, in hopes to program his own video game one day.

It is amazing and encouraging that when these students were sitting in their room doing nothing, Youth Life came to mind as a place that would change that.

Anthony Bastardi, a loving husband, father, and long-term member of Northside Church of Richmond, has graciously given his time and effort at YLFR for 7 years. In that time he has been a consistent mentor to students in the program, and on several occasions has used his knowledge of computer technology to give free tech support to Youth Life staff members.

When Anthony began at Youth Life, he faithfully mentored the same student, Nassan Carter, for over five years. The following year he found himself joyfully working in the high school program mentoring Kevaughn Brooks, yet was willing to leave that role upon the request of the high school teacher to serve where there was a greater need in the middle school program. This year Anthony has been willing to increase his time at Youth Life and now shows up two days out of the week. On Mondays he floats between two students in the middle school program, and on Tuesdays he started teaching one of the high schoolers the basics of computer programming, in the hopes that this student, Lionell Prescod, could get into CodeRVA and continue learning that valuable skill.

Upon reflection, Anthony has mentioned that it has been hard at times mentoring at Youth Life. He says that each mentee presents their own unique challenges, yet there has been much joy and encouragement in the larger community at Youth Life. To serve alongside the members and staff from his own church has been a blessing to him, and he is reminded that, "I'm not alone, but surrounded by those from my local body of Christ."

Anthony shines brightly as a faithful servant in the Youth Life family. His strength to press on comes from a great hope. He reminds himself that, "...at times God may be using me to plant seeds that may not sprout for some time to come. My hope is that even if I don't see immediate fruit from my labor, somehow God is using me to have an impact for his Kingdom." Anthony recognizes that we don't always see the fruit of our labor nor understand all that God is doing in hard situations, but strength to keep going comes from a full reliance on God and God alone.

MISS LEXI & CADARAH

Each Tuesday afternoon a similar question is asked by fourth grader, Cadarah Williams. "Is Miss Lexi coming today?". The confirmation of her mentor's attendance leads to a shout of glee and the anticipation of Miss Lexi's arrival. Alexis Olney, also known as "Miss Lexi" has been mentoring Cadarah since February of 2016. She graduated in May with a bachelor's degree from University of Richmond in May with accounting as her major and film studies as her minor.

Cadarah's relationship with Miss Lexi has been a comfort and encouragement the past three and a half years. Lexi is a dedicated mentor that cares for Cadarah so well with her words and actions. There have been numerous occasions when Lexi has stayed late to help Cadarah finish her homework, which meant the world to Cadarah. It's quite obvious to anyone at the Learning Center that Lexi cares deeply for Cadarah, but when asked how she knows Miss Lexi cares for her Cadarah simply stated "because she comes to the Learning Center to help me every week." Lexi's dedication and consistency has clearly made a deep impact on her mentee. Not only does Lexi attend her weekly mentoring sessions, but she has also taken additional time to hang out with Cadarah outside of Learning Center hours. This strengthened her bond with Cadarah and has created a foundation of trust between them. Cadarah said that her favorite memory with Miss Lexi is when they went to Sweet Frog together after Learning Center.

When asked about her experience mentoring Cadarah at the Delmont Learning Center Lexi replied, "I am so grateful for my relationship with Cadarah. She and all the kids at Youth Life are such an inspiration to me. Mentoring Cadarah has truly been the best experience I have had in college."

VERITAS SCHOOL

Part of the vision for YLFR's volunteer program is to foster mutually enriching, cross-cultural relationships where both parties offer and receive varied perspectives. A growing partnership with Veritas has been a great example of that. Veritas is a JK-12 classical Christian school located less than a mile from YLFR's Northminster site. In 2013, the school moved to the Northside of Richmond with a desire to connect and engage with their neighbors and to be an asset to the community, including stewardship of its nearly century-old campus, hospitality to non-profits and ministries for special events, and service opportunities for students.

Throughout the years, students from Veritas have cleaned our Learning Centers and buses and assisted teachers with simple classroom tasks during the school's Day of Service. Teen leaders from Youth Life and Veritas are also working closely together to prepare for the annual Run for Mukhanyo, with proceeds going to support a Christian school in South Africa for children who've been orphaned through the AIDS crisis. Additionally, Lilli Benko, Strings Program Director at Veritas, implemented a 'pre-beginner' curriculum she created for Veritas 4th graders with the 3rd-5th graders at our Northside centers. The short-term enrichment class was designed to give a simple hands-on introduction to the violin and was received with enthusiasm by YLFR students.

Other Veritas individuals have served as afterschool mentors, summer interns, and Fun Run volunteers. This past year alone, YLFR had six students, three staff members, and three parents from Veritas volunteering at our Learning Centers on a regular basis. The connections and relationships that have been built with these neighbors have been a blessing for both sides!


