# The Chapel *Scott's Addition*

Youth Life's relationship with The Chapel goes all the way back to our earliest days. In 2002, before our first Learning Center (Delmont) had even opened its doors, Rob Rhoden—soon-to-be founding pastor of the then-named Commonwealth Chapel—put on some work clothes and helped paint our very first classroom. That early partnership continued, as Commonwealth Chapel supplied our students with Bibles, helped to fund Mystery Trips, and even hosted our very first I Have a Dream event.

It's amazing how God can often bring things full circle. Although there was a pause in partnership after Pastor Rhoden left, the Lord reconnected The Chapel and Youth Life a few years ago through Nate Jones, Todd Compton, and others. Since then, The Chapel (and the Scott's Addition location in particular) has fervently supported Youth Life's mission and vision in beautiful ways. In addition to giving monthly, they have purchased and filled backpacks for our Delmont students and hosted our 2022 and 2023 I Have a Dream events. Last year, both Chapel campuses took up an offering during their summer VBS and donated the sum (a total of \$6,000) to Youth Life.

We are so thankful for the multifaceted and incredibly generous partnership of this church, and we are honored to be working together to bring the Kingdom of God to earth.

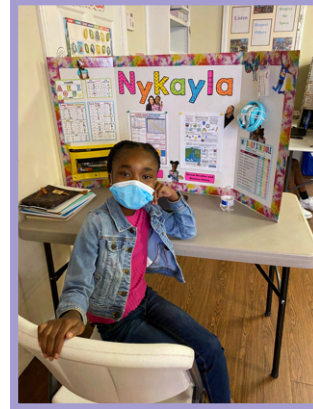

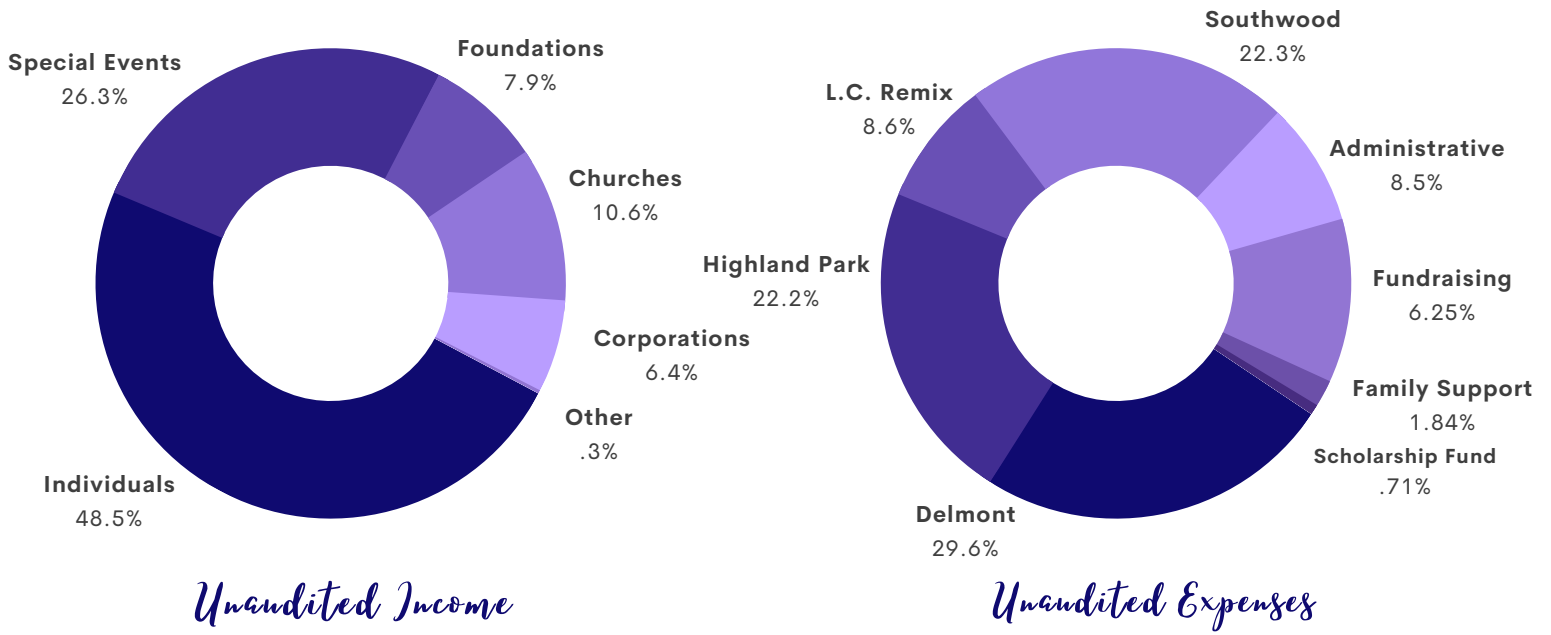
