MENTOR SPOTLIGHT

MYRSINI MANOU-GEORGILA

With a beaming smile and contagious laughter, Myrsini Manou-Georgila enters the Delmont Learning Center each week, excited to see the students and spend time together. Myrsini is a senior at University of Richmond, graduating this spring with a degree in Mathematics and Global Studies. She has faithfully volunteered at the Delmont Learning Center the past 4 years and was University of Richmond's Youth Life Mentor Organization's treasurer for a number of years as well.

Myrsini began mentoring during her freshman year of college and quickly bonded with the students, especially her mentee, Nykayla. Nykayla looks forward to her time with Miss Myrsini each week, though she still struggles with the pronunciation of her name, calling her "Miss Myrsinti" or "Miss Martini." Myrsini always welcomed this greeting (no matter how her name was pronounced) with a huge smile and laughter. Myrsini's favorite memory of her time with her mentee was when Nykayla read her Dream speech at the 2020 "I Have a Dream" event. The speech was written during their mentoring time. Myrsini remembers this moment fondly. "It was really humbling and rewarding witnessing how she expressed her thoughts and feelings in her speeches progressively, from the moment she wrote them down on paper to the moment she read them out loud in front of so many of her friends and family."

Since she grew up in Greece, Myrsini has been able to incorporate her own perspective and knowledge of the world outside the United States into her mentoring sessions. During her summer internship, she planned and executed a weeklong Greek elective for students. She shared about the history, geography, and beauty of Greece, along with some artifacts and special mementos she brought to the states with her.

Myrsini feels as though she also is leaving her mentoring experience with a new perspective. "It has been truly inspiring seeing the world and life from the eyes of these kids, with their curiosity and excitement, their well-thought-out questions, their bravery, their big hearts and minds, their tireless spirit and crazy energy, their passion and compassion. Every time I would be with them, they reminded me how I needed to take a step out of the adult world and just see the world through their eyes."

Academically, Kelly has become more confident in her math and has improved greatly in her writing. She has memorized which day of the week each of her mentors come and greatly looks forward to spending time with them.

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT

ART FOR THE JOURNEY

Art for the Journey is a Richmond-based nonprofit whose mission is to overcome barriers and transform lives through creating art. This belief that art can be used to promote positive mental health and well-being, is what inspired Art for the Journey (AFJ) to partner with Youth Life Foundation since the organization's formation in 2014. For the past six years, AFJ has provided enriching artistic opportunities on Fun Fridays either by inviting students to their art studio or by visiting YLFR's learning centers.

Volunteers and staff of Art for the Journey support and celebrate students through the art-making process while providing quality art supplies and instruction. When elementary aged children attend, lead artist, Jamie Wigginton, reads them a story which serves as a springboard for an art project, which can range from acrylic painting on canvas to multi-media projects, mosaics or abstract pieces. Middle and high school students are also exposed to a multitude of art media. Projects are always open-ended so that students can make personal choices to make their work unique. Through the support and encouragement of many AFJ volunteers and a failure-free art-making approach, children arrive with excitement and leave with a sense of joy and accomplishment, as well as original artwork to hang in their homes. Their smiling faces speak volumes!

Northminster's Program Director, Leahna Sullivan, can personally attest to the impact that AFJ had on one of her students in particular. The unexpected death of a family member drove a typical second grader into solitude, as though, "the joy had drained out of him." Any attempt to get him involved and reconnected was met with disinterest until one Fun Friday with AFJ. As he put paint to canvas, Ms. Sullivan states, "I could literally see a light return to his eyes. He was engaged. He was excited. He was smiling. It was like in that one activity, he found a way to let go and realized that he could still experience joy in life amidst the pain, and that it was ok to do so."

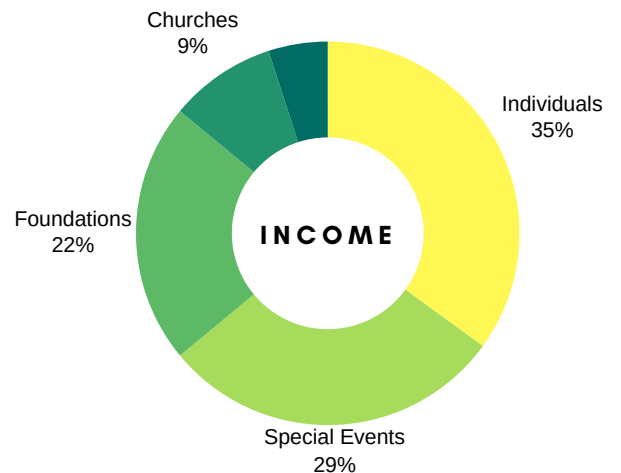
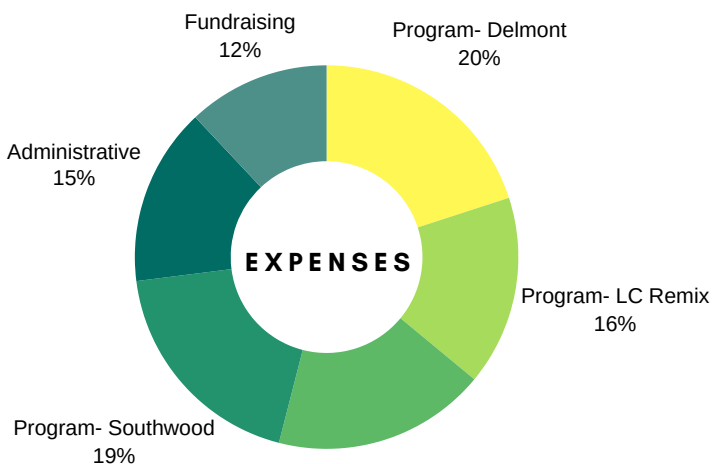
